Calculus Exam Takeaways (26-April-2024):

- Try to be on time but not the end of the world if you're not there 20 minutes early.
- I could put my backpack and everything else next to the lockers in the room and there was a coat hanger as well.
- I didn't really need anything as there was a Dutch dictionary, calculator, paper for notes and even pens in case you forget your own although I still recommend you take one of those.
- The room I had to be in, B3.08, location: Vista College Arendstraat 12, Sittard can be a bit of a pain to find even though you can get there relatively fine by following the signs. If you want to find where it is you can find the floor plan as shown HERE. (*You can find the floor plans for all locations this way)
- I had 150 minutes for a total of 35 questions so I think the time given to comfortably complete the test is very adequate if you actually put some basic effort into calculus for the modules that need some extra attention.

Really it is just a normal test but in a different location. If you have put any effort at all into calculus you should be totally fine so don't worry about it.
